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CLNG Congratulates Dominion's Cove Point on Commissioning Cargo

(Washington, D.C.) – Speaking on behalf of the Center for LNG (CLNG), Executive Director Charlie Riedl expressed his support over the news that Cove Point has exported its first commissioning cargo.

Riedl said:

“Today marks an important day, not just for Cove Point, but for the U.S. LNG industry. Cove Point’s first commissioning cargo represents a growing industry. This is the second U.S. LNG export facility, the first on the East Coast, and one of many to come. The projects provide thousands of jobs at home and environmental and geopolitical benefits abroad.

“This cargo represents countless hours of work from thousands of people and \$4 billion of investment, the largest construction investment in Maryland’s history.

“The vast natural gas resources in the U.S. enable LNG exports to bring significant benefits to communities right here at home. As more LNG exports come online, those benefits will increase exponentially, in terms of job creation, investment and supply contracts across the whole natural gas supply chain.”
