## Center for LNG Statement on the Administration's Announcement of Steel and Aluminum Tariffs

(Washington, D.C.) -- In reaction to this morning's announcement by President Trump regarding the imposition of tariffs on foreign imported steel and aluminum, the Center for Liquefied Natural Gas issued the following statement:

## Charlie Riedl, Executive Director of the Center for Liquefied Natural Gas (CLNG), said:

"We are concerned that the Administration's plan to impose tariffs on steel could have the unintended effect of endangering much-needed U.S. LNG export projects. These projects benefit the economy, create jobs, improve our trade deficit and provide global environmental benefits. The Administration had taken meaningful steps to improve the current permit review process for natural gas infrastructure and it would be unfortunate if their steel tariffs created new and different barriers to projects."
