Center for LNG Statement on U.S.-European Union Remarks on LNG

(Washington, D.C.) – In response to remarks by President Trump and European Union Commission President Jean Claude Juncker today, the Center for Liquefied Natural Gas (CLNG) Executive Director Charlie Riedl issued the following statement:

“We welcome these remarks focused on U.S.-European Union LNG trade. Because of our abundant resources, America can provide affordable, reliable, and clean natural gas to allies and partners around the globe. The U.S. has already exported 28 cargoes totaling 86 billion cubic feet of natural gas to members of the European Union and will look to build on that success.

“The national security benefits of allies and partners in the EU diversifying their energy portfolios with American LNG are real and can help provide stability and certainty abroad.

“We are encouraged by the initial dialogue and look forward to providing support and greater energy options to European partners.”
