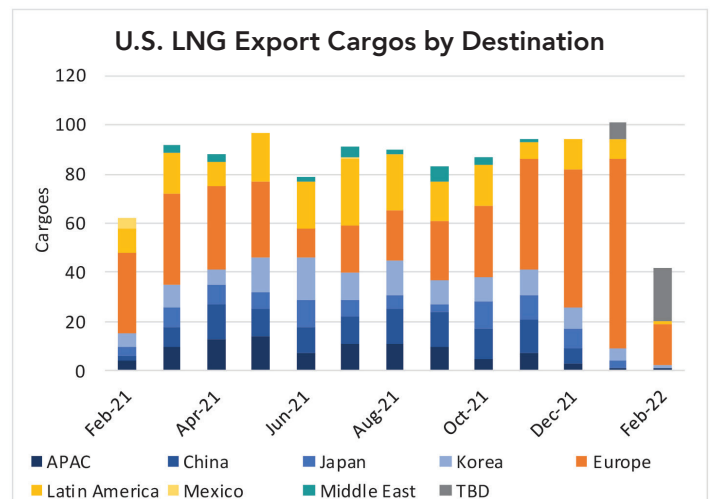
U.S. LNG EXPORTS BY THE NUMBERS

The U.S. LNG industry has been the largest supplier of liquefied natural gas to Europe throughout their energy crisis and **we reaffirm our willingness to help our allies in their time of need.**

OF THE 98 LNG CARGOES that departed the United States in January 2022, **75 WERE SENT TO EUROPE.**

EUROPE HAS RECEIVED NEARLY 70% OF ALL U.S. LNG cargoes exported in February 2022.

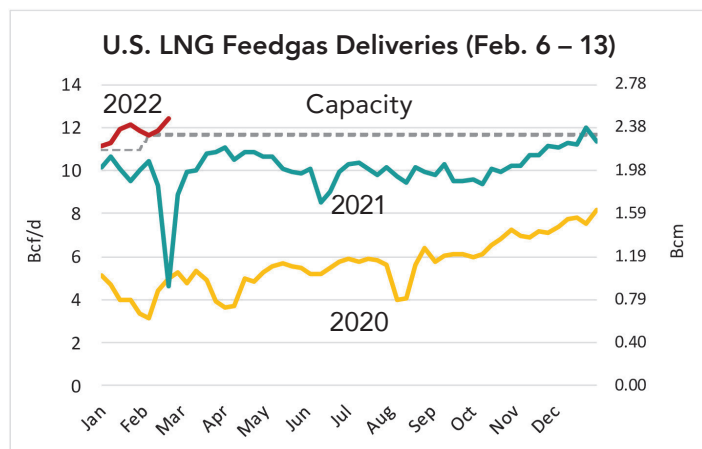
MORE THAN 775 BILLION CUBIC FEET OF U.S. LNG REACHED EUROPE IN 2021.

The U.S. LNG industry is operating at full capacity, **receiving more feedgas and producing more of this critical fuel than ever before.**

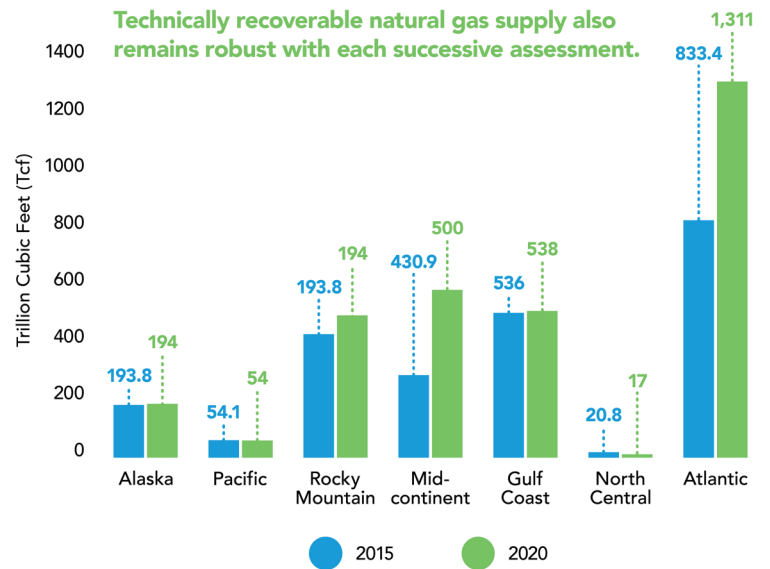
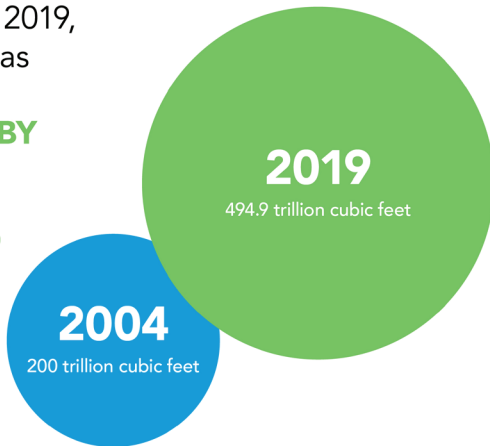
From Feb. 6 through Feb. 13...

- **Deliveries of feedgas** — the dry natural gas used as raw material to produce LNG — **averaged 11.88 billion cubic feet per day Bcf/d. This is above full utilization levels** at in-service U.S. LNG terminals.
- Those same in-service terminals **produced 12.63 Bcf/d of LNG**, which was then loaded onto cargo ships for export.
- **Twenty-six LNG cargoes** departed from U.S. terminals, seven more than the previous week.

BUILDING RESERVES, GROWING SUPPLY

U.S. proved reserves of natural gas are enormous – but that’s just one part of a future supply that keeps growing.

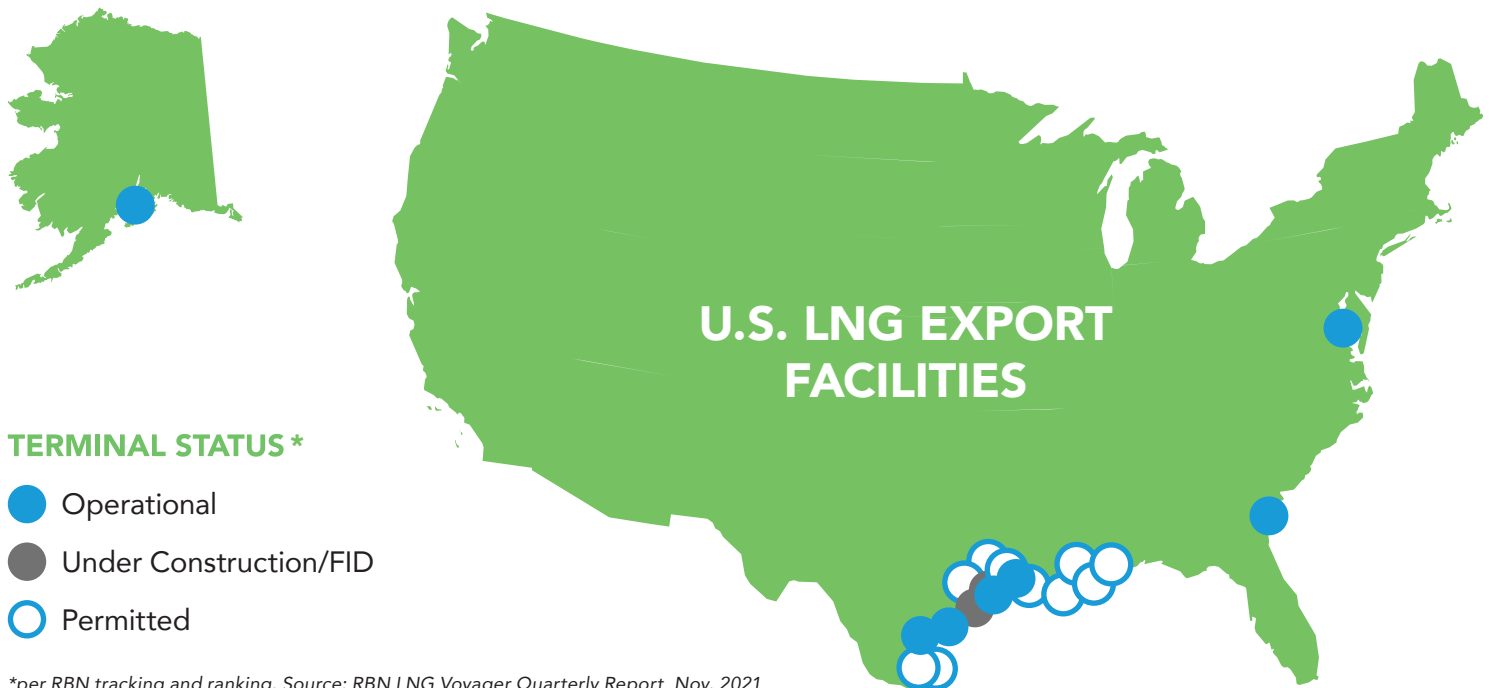
From 2004 to 2019,
