# NGSA and CLNG Statement on Redesignation of FERC Policy Statements as Drafts

(Washington, D.C.) -- The Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA) and the Center for LNG (CLNG) issued the following statement about today's announcement from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) that it is redesignating its certificate and greenhouse gas policy statements as drafts.

### Dena Wiggins, President and CEO of NGSA, said:

"We are pleased that FERC listened to our request for a better process that allows a robust discussion with stakeholders. We welcome this new opportunity to be a part of developing more workable policies that provide regulatory certainty and support future infrastructure projects, which would enable the natural gas industry to continue our critical role in achieving the ambitious goal of a net-zero emissions future."

#### Charlie Riedl, Executive Director, Center for LNG, said:

"We welcome the redesignation by FERC and look forward to working with them through the comment process. President Biden is meeting with European leaders in Brussels right now to identify ways that we can help provide much-needed U.S. LNG to our allies, including greater regulatory certainty around the permitting of LNG infrastructure, a critical element of U.S. leadership in addressing global climate and energy security issues. We believe FERC policy should align with those goals."
