NGSA and CLNG Statement on Senate Confirmation of Nominees to FERC

(Washington, D.C.) -- Dena E. Wiggins, President and CEO of the Natural Gas Supply Association (NGSA), and Charlie Riedl, Executive Director of the Center for LNG (CLNG), made the following statement on the Senate's votes yesterday and today to confirm David Rosner, Linday See, and Judy Chang to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC).

NGSA President and CEO Dena Wiggins said:

"We congratulate the three nominees and look forward to working with Commissioners Rosner, See, and Chang as they take on their new responsibilities. FERC has an essential role in ensuring that natural gas is able to provide affordable, reliable and lower-emissions energy and we need FERC's continued leadership in this area."
